The Institution:

CAMICISSIMA is the famous brand of the historical shirt shop Fenicia, specialized in the production of shirts since 1931. Currently Fenicia SPA directly manage 120 stores displaced on the Italian territory, 3 stores in U.S.A., 1 in Egypt, 2 in Poland, 4 in Greece, 1 in Lebanon. Many new stores are going to be opened in other countries.

The Challenge

In the Year that celebrates 80 years since its foundation, Candido brothers, mr. Sergio and mr. Fabio, President and managing Director have a very firm and structured organization, employing 350 people.

The direct management of more than 100 shops worldwide imposes a quick and efficient centralized information and communication system.

Not least, management and communication for sales people should be as simple as possible, and should be managed remotely by qualified personnel, to avoid wasting time and money for traveling technicians.



The Solution

All shops must be able to access the main server at Headquarters, Headquarters must be able to communicate with each store free of charge via VoIP. In addition, there must be a backup line for internet connection in case the primary line goes down.

All stores need also to communicate with customers through standard PSTN/ISDN lines, and the use of VoIP account to save money should be transparent to sales people.

Camicissima stores adopted DrayTek Vigor2820VSn as global solution, this single device allow VPN connection with Headquarters, Internet backup through 2nd WAN or 3G USB key, thanks to his FXS port for analog phone and his ISDN port for ISDN phone, it can manage one PSTN and one ISDN line, as well as 12 VoIP accounts.

Moreover, the management of all CPEs is done remotely from Headquarters, through TR-069 protocol and VigorACS SI, a powerful centralized management system to manage DrayTek's devices in the most convenient way. TR069-based VigorACS SI with user-friendly interface helps Headquarters technicians to maintain the configuration of store's CPE easily and quickly.
