

Release Note for Port Knocking Tool

Firmware Version:	1.5
Release Type:	Regular – Upgrade recommended when convenient, as it includes general improvements and optimizations

The Port Knocking Tool is an application designed to work with Vigor Routers. When Port Knocking protection is enabled on a Vigor Router, the administrators can use this tool to perform the required 'knocks' and gain access to the router's management interface.

New Features

- None.

Improvement

- Improved: Added missing translations for the above changes across all 10 supported languages.
- Improved: Importing an encrypted export file with multiple profiles now only asks for the passphrase once, instead of once per profile.
- Improved: Cancelling the passphrase prompt now skips all remaining encrypted profiles in that file at once, instead of asking again for each one.
- Improved: Re-prompt only for profiles that cannot be opened with the cached passphrase when importing a file containing profiles encrypted with different passphrases.
- Improved: Added an "Auto" option to the CLI command generator's OS selector, which automatically detects Windows / macOS / Linux and generates the matching open command.
- Corrected: An issue where entering an incorrect passphrase during import caused the import to fail outright.
- Corrected: An issue with a wording typo in the local storage notice ("browser's local storage" → "browser local storage").

- All entered data is securely stored in your browser's local storage and will not be transmitted to any external servers, such as www.draytek.com.
- The profile settings for the Port Knocking tool are saved in the browser cache. Please note that these settings will be lost if you use Incognito mode or clear the browser cache. It is recommended that you record the settings using a separate application in advance.
